Inadvertent Ingestion of Silica Gel

Silica gel, which is the material used as drying agent in the packing of many Sanner products, contains synthetic amorphous silicon dioxide, which is not supposed to be eaten. However silicon dioxide is not toxic. Silica gel is hygroscopic which means that when accidentally being consumed/swallowed the product will attract moisture from the surroundings i.e. the gastrointestinal (GI) tract.

Silicon Dioxide is not considered to be persistent, bioaccumulating nor toxic (PBT).

According to the safety data sheets from the manufacturers of the Silica Gel, we can inform you that the first aid advice after swallowing is to rinse mouth with water and to drink afterwards plenty of water. If symptoms persist a doctor should be consulted.
