Inadvertent Ingestion of Molecular Sieve

Molecular sieve, which is the material used as drying agent in the packing of many Sanner products, consists of crystalline aluminosilicates (zeolites), which is not supposed to be eaten. However molecular sieve is not toxic. Molecular sieve is hygroscopic which means that when accidentally being consumed/swallowed the product will attract moisture from the surroundings i.e. the gastrointestinal (GI) tract.

Molecular sieves are not considered to be persistent, bioaccumulating nor toxic (PBT).

According to the safety data sheets from the manufacturers of molecular sieve, we can inform you that the first aid advice after swallowing is to rinse mouth with water and to drink afterwards plenty of water. If symptoms persist a doctor should be consulted.
